DID YOU KNOW?


You can translate the languages even without an internet connection. Just remember to tick **translate offline** when you see it.

STEP 1 Install the Google Translate App on your mobile phone


Go to the **Apple App Store**  or **Google Play Store**  to download the **Google Translate App** and launch the application.

1. For iOS users, tap on 'Get' to download the app.
2. For Android users, tap on 'Install' to download the app.

STEP 2A Use written or typing mode




3. Select main language and language to be translated to. Click **Finish** once selections are made.



4. Enter the phrase or words you want to communicate or tap on  to access the **writing** function.




5. If using handwriting function, write the word that you want to translate in the blank box on the lower half of the screen.




6. The phrase will be automatically translated. E.g. Key in hello, Tap on **你好** to proceed

STEP 2B Using Camera Mode



7. Tap on the  and allow access to the camera feature.



8. By default, you will begin with **Instant** when accessing Camera Mode. Align your phone camera to translate the text instantly.



9. Tap on  to access the import function, where you can select images from your phone gallery to translate.

Cyber security tips

- Google Translate **should never** be used for translating **highly-sensitive content** that contains personal data or other important information whether you are using **secured or unsecured network**. Once you enter the text in the tool, it becomes the property of Google, and they can use the data at their discretion.
